The Mini-Con Package

(\$80 for members or \$90 for non-members) consists of the following:

- This package can only be purchased in conjunction with the Primus Package and is offered so that accompanying family members can join in the fun. Each Primus Package is limited to one Mini-Con Package.*†

The **Protoform Package** (\$135 for club members or \$200 for non-members) consists of the following:

- Convention pin.

- Items will be shipped three to four weeks after the show to your home address. (Use the BotCon registration form to order this package.)

Additional Details

The first 100 Primus or Iacon Package registrations will receive a special *Transformers* cloisonné lapel pin.

In addition, 400 pieces of the five-figure convention set: Kup, Thunderclash, Landshark, Flak, and Scourge, (in poly bags, no box, no certificate, etc) will be available for \$199. Only *Transformers Collectors' Club Member* Primus or Iacon Package holders can take advantage of this offer and sets will be sold on a first-come, first-served basis. This is a great way to increase your 'bots for maximum display impact without having to take your figures out of the display box. Our special convention figures will NEVER be sold at retail stores and are extremely limited. This extra set is limited to one per Primus or Iacon Package purchased.

Just as in past years, there will be a limited number of souvenir figures available at the show. Registered attendees will have first purchasing opportunity starting on Thursday night during registration pick-up.

Package confirmations will begin mailing in March. Packages are limited so sign up early!



Dealer Information

Dealer booths are \$300. Fee includes two 8' tables, one 6' table and 2 Dealer badges. Booth size is approximately 11' wide by 8' deep. Single tables are available for \$180 and include one badge. Booths

and tables are limited. Each Dealer booth will receive one surprise bonus figure. Multiple Dealer booth contracts and payments received by March 10, 2009 will receive a \$20 discount (single booths and single tables are not discounted and single tables are limited to one per dealer, not combinable with a booth). Artists - don't forget that you can get single tables to show-and-sell your custom *Transformers* art!

Standard electrical hookups for all booths or tables are \$100 per hookup (total for all three days). Telephone service can be provided at a cost of \$190 (total for all three days). Placement in the ballroom will be assigned in the order the registrations are received. The earlier your registration is received, the closer your booth will be to the front of the Sales Room. The entire facility is air-conditioned and carpeted. Dealer's product content must be at least 50% *Transformers* related. This means robots, action figures, comics, sci-fi or related products. General toys or dolls are not allowed. Dealers must collect the 8.25% California sales tax or current rate in effect at the time of the show. Dealers must obtain a California sales tax permit from <http://www.boe.ca.gov/pdf/boe400spa.pdf> before the show (takes 2-3 weeks). Please bring your permit to registration.

Dealers can drop their items into their space from 8:30 pm-9:30 pm on Thursday night. Dealer set-up is from 7:30 am-2:00 pm on Friday. You must wear your Dealer Badge to enter the Sales Room at anytime during the show or set-up.



Shipping

If you have small inbound shipments, please give us a call or consult with your hotel concerning charges. If you have large shipments, please call our office so that we can give you directions on how to send a timed shipment. These shipments will need to ship to the Pasadena Convention Center and can only arrive on Thursday. The UPS Store will have a booth at the show to assist you in shipping your items home. They will have all types of packing materials and boxes available.

Hotel Accommodations

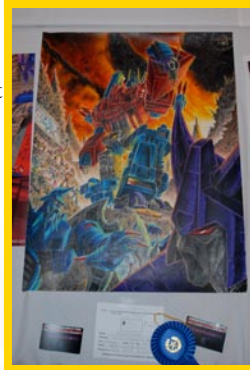

Hasbro Designers' Art Contests

Over \$1,000 worth of prizes will be awarded! Each art contest will be judged by Hasbro designers and the winners will receive show dollars that they can spend with any dealer at the show. If you are planning to bring a display or contest entry, please contact us prior to May 1, to ensure that we have space allocated. All entries must be in place for judging by noon on Friday.



There are five different art contests:

- 3-D Custom Figure (space limited to 24" x 24") - Prizes: 1st \$125, 2nd \$65, and 3rd \$35. Contest is limited to ONE figure per entry, no teams or squads.
- Diorama (size limit: 48" x 30", as many figures as you desire) - Prizes: 1st \$150, 2nd \$75, and 3rd \$40.
- 2-D Computer Generated Art - Prizes: 1st \$100, 2nd \$50, and 3rd \$25.
- 2-D Hand Drawn Art Color - Prizes: 1st \$100, 2nd \$50, and 3rd \$25.
- 2-D Hand Drawn Art Black and White - Prizes: 1st \$100, 2nd \$50, and 3rd \$25. (All 2-D entries must not be larger than 20" x 24" and not smaller than 8" x 10". 2-D entries must be mounted on foam board or cardboard so that they can be hung on the wall. Please let us know by May 1 if you need to mount your entry at the convention so we can have the appropriate supplies available.

Entries must stay within the dimensions for the contest being entered.



Oversized pieces will not be accepted. There is a limit of two entries per person, per contest and you must be present to enter. Please do not bring any entries that have won in past convention contests. All winners will be announced Saturday night at the Party at Paramount! If you would like the judging criteria, please send us a SASE or download it from BotCon.com.

There will also be an area for kids to show their special *Transformers* displays. Each child is limited to one display that will fit inside a 24" x 24" space. Please let us know by May 1 if you are bringing a kid's display so that we can allocate space.

Special Guests/ Panels and Seminars

Transformers Customizing Classes

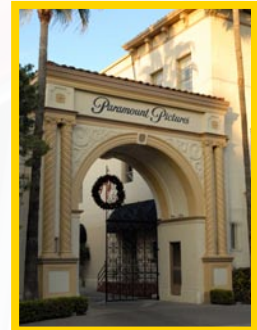

Door Prizes

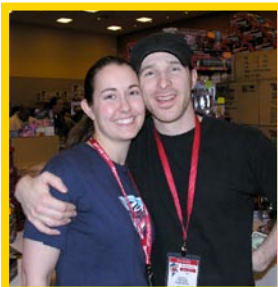
